1. THE KENTUCKY STANDARDS | \$19

This flight is the perfect introduction to the Bluegrass State, showcasing the major flavor profiles of classic bourbon. Experience the small-batch craft of Elijah Craig, the delicate floral spice of Four Roses, and the quintessential sweetness of Buffalo Trace.

2. THE IRISH TRINITY | \$19

Irish whiskey is famous for its triple-distilled smoothness, but this trio proves it can also be bold and complex. We start with the approachable honeyed notes of Tullamore D.E.W. and the malt-heavy richness of Old Bushmills, one of the world's oldest licensed distilleries. The journey finishes with Keeper's Heart, a modern innovation that blends Irish grain with American bourbon for a unique trans-Atlantic flavor profile.

3. RYE REVIVAL | \$19

Before bourbon became King, Rye was the original spirit of the American colonies. This flight explores the spicy, dry, and herbaceous character of the rye grain, contrasting the classic Pennsylvania style of Rittenhouse with the smooth Iowa corn influence of Templeton. The finish features WhistlePig's PiggyBack, a 100% rye mash bill that delivers an explosion of cinnamon and black pepper.

4. TOUR OF SCOTLAND | \$30

Scotland's whisky regions are as diverse as its landscape. Begin in the lush valley of Speyside with Glenfiddich, move to the coastal Highlands for the honeyed Oban, and finish on the wind-swept island of Islay with the smoky peat of Laphroaig.

This vertical tasting lets you experience how their signature profile evolves from their Small Batch to the sweet complexity of the Ambrosia and the boldness of the Patton Road Reserve.

Tradition meets experimentation in this flight designed for the curious palate. The finale is Old Elk, which uses smooth Cognac casks to impart a velvety, sophisticated finish to their high-malt bourbon.

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THE WILLETT DISTILLERY COLLECTION

A historic, family-owned icon of Bardstown, Kentucky, Willett is renowned for its independent spirit and "cult-like" following. After a multi-decade hiatus from distilling, the family returned to their copper pot stills in 2012, blending deep heritage with a modern, artisanal approach.

THE MICTER'S DISTILLERY COLLECTION

Tracing its roots back to 1753 as America's first whiskey company, Michter's was reborn in Kentucky with a "cost-be-damned" philosophy. They are famous for their "Signature Filtration" and for barreling at a lower entry proof, which creates a richer, smoother, and more concentrated flavor profile.

WISCONSIN HERITAGE: J. HENRY & SONS

FEATURE: THE RED CORN RESURRECTION This is true "farm-to-glass" whiskey, distilled in Dane County, WI, using a rare heirloom red corn (W335A) that was developed by the University of Wisconsin in 1939 and nearly went extinct before the Henry family resurrected it. The spirit is aged in a non-climate-controlled 100-year-old dairy barn, where the brutal Wisconsin winters and humid summers force the whiskey deep into the oak, creating a rich, creamy profile that rivals much older Kentucky bourbons. Every step of the process is managed by the Henry family on the land they have farmed for four generations.

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BOURBON

Bourbon is America's native spirit, distilled from a mash of at least 51% corn to create a naturally sweet foundation. It must be aged in new, charred oak barrels, which impart the whiskey's signature amber color and rich notes of vanilla, caramel, and spice. While historically linked to Kentucky, this distinctive style of whiskey can be produced anywhere in the United States.

Founded in 1824 by Alexander Reid, The Macallan was one of the first legally licensed distilleries in Scotland, situated on a plateau above the River Spey. The estate is anchored by the historic Easter Elchies House, a Highland manor built in 1700 that remains the spiritual home of the brand today. Over the last two centuries, they have cemented their legacy through an obsession with their 'curiously small' copper stills and an uncompromising dedication to sherry-seasoned oak casks.
